In her position Ms. Jordan will be responsible for implementing all grantmaking activities of the Foundation, including the management of special programs and initiatives. She will lead the Foundation's signature literacy program READy for the Grade, a partnership with public libraries across NewAlliance Foundation's service area designed to prepare K-3 children for grade level reading.
